

Places You May Need to Notify Following a Death

- Alberta Health Care 780-407-1432 (have the AHC # ready)**
- Alberta Blue Cross 780-498-8100 or other private health care coverage** (have plan and ID number ready)
- Government Pension Plans**
- Canada Customs and Revenue Agency** (income tax): **1-800-959-1953**
- Corporate or Private Pension Plans**
- Employee Benefits:** Call human resources department to find out if there was insurance coverage or death benefits
- Insurance Policies:** Check the deceased's files for any insurance policies and contact the appropriate agencies on what to do next.
- Old Age Security/Canada Pension Plan 1-800-277-9914** (have SIN number ready). Through CPP, a death benefit and/or survivors benefit may be available to you.
- Land titles office, Alberta Government Services re: change of titles for real estate.**
- Alberta Registries:** listed in the Yellow Pages under License and Registry Services (for **Drivers License, Health Care Card, Death Certificate**)
- Passport**
- Banks (accounts and safety deposit boxes) & Investment Institutes**
- Registered Retirement Saving Plans (RRSP)**
- Credit Cards**
- Telephone, gas, power, and cable TV, internet companies**

- Canada Post:** contact local post office if mail needs to be cancelled or redirected.
- Car insurance and registration**
- Home, vehicle and or Life Insurance Companies**
- Magazine/book club subscriptions**
- Veteran's Affairs – English: 1-866-522-2122 French: 1-866-522-2022**
- Lawyer:** Is there a will?

Some of the places may require a "funeral director's 'statement of death". This statement is provided by the funeral home (usually included in the service package price).

This statements differs from the statement of death provided by the Doctor. On occasion, a Provincial Death Certificate is obtained through any Alberta Registry (listed in the Yellow Pages under License and Registry Services). This provincial death certificate can take several weeks to be processed. Cost averages \$35.00 - \$40.00 depending on how soon it is required. This provincial death certificate may be needed is the deceased have a life insurance policy.
